CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

The forum is open to all students or fresh graduates working on Asia-related subjects. Those willing to present their work are invited to submit their proposal following the instructions described in the GUIDELINES FOR PRESENTER CANDIDATES below. The call for participation lasts from November 1, 2017 to January 31, 2018. The selected proposals will be communicated to their authors between December 2017 and February 2018.

INTRODUCTION

Many universities in the world propose Asian Studies in their study programme. Many students in Asian Studies have produced interesting scientific works in the forms of working paper, bachelor's or master's thesis. Yet, their works remain unknown to the general public or academic circles due to the fact that they are not published. It seems therefore relevant to create a forum that allows students to present their work and to physically meet with their fellow students in Asian Studies from all over the world. The International and Multidisciplinary Conference THE RISE OF ASIA IN GLOBAL HISTORY AND PERSPECTIVE that will take place in Paris and Le Havre on March 14-16, 2018, will be a good opportunity to organise such a forum. It is in this perspective that ASEA (Association of Students in Exchanges with Asia) of the University Le Havre Normandy proposes a Student Forum in Asian Studies. The Forum will take place at the University Le Havre Normandy on March 15-16, 2018. Students or fresh graduates in Asian Studies or doing academic work on Asia from all over the world willing to participate in the Forum are invited to send the abstract of their work following the guidelines for presenter's candidates described below. The organising committee will provide a roundtrip train ticket Paris-Le Havre and a two-night hotel room in Le Havre to a number of selected presenters.

The Forum is also a part of the ASIA WEEK organised annually by ASEA. The ASIA WEEK will take place at the University Le Havre Normandy on March 14-16, 2018. It is a three-day presentation of Asian cultures through exhibition, conferences, calligraphies, origami, café-languages, dances, music, martial-arts, gastronomy, defile of traditional costumes, film screening... representing diverse cultural areas of Asia, especially China (and other Chinese speaking countries like Taiwan and Singapore), Indonesia (and other Malay speaking countries like Brunei, Malaysia and Singapore), Japan, Korea and Russia (and other Russian speaking countries like Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan) but also Cambodia, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, etc.

GUIDELINES FOR PRESENTER CANDIDATES

The selection of presenters will be done by the Organising Committee of the Forum under the supervision of the Scientific Board of the conference THE RISE OF ASIA. The selection is based on the abstract and the basic personal data of the presenter candidates in respect to the following dates:

1. Deadline for abstract submission: January 31, 2018
2. Announce of the selected presenters: December 2017-February 2018

The abstract is limited to approximately 300 words (figures, tables, and references should not be included in the abstract) accompanied by basic personal data of the author(s) including:

- Full name and surname
- Gender (male/female/other)
- Affiliated University, Faculty and Department
- Study programme (Bachelor's or Master's Degree and its specialisation)
- Full address (physical/postal address, phone and fax numbers, email)

FINANCING

The presenters as well as simple participants of the Forum are supposed to find the necessary fund for their own participation (visa, international and national transport, accommodation). The organising committee will provide a roundtrip train ticket Paris-Le Havre and a two-night hotel room in Le Havre to a number of selected presenters.

PRACTICAL MATTERS

The organising committee will provide practical information related to local hotels and transport in Paris and Le Havre. The participants will be accompanied by students of the Université Le Havre Normandie in Master's Degree in Exchanges with Asia (with their language proficiencies in Chinese, Indonesian, Japanese, Korean and Russian, in addition to English and French).
